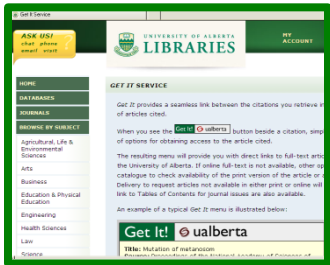

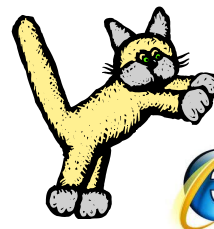
Do you do research using Internet Explorer (IE)?



Ah... there is something you should know about a little **GetIt!** glitch on IE.

Imagine. One day you open up Internet Explorer (IE), which is a fine Internet browser.

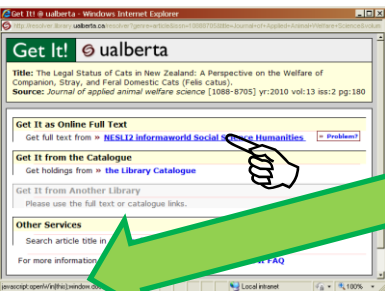


You are doing research, say, on **cats as companions** and your search is going very well: articles are appropriate and copious, many of them are available as full-text PDFs, and that **GetIt!** button system works like a charm...



Until suddenly, **GetIt!** doesn't get it anymore! Ah!

Look at the bottom left hand side of the **GetIt!** window.



When things are going well, and you mouse over a database in the list, you will see something like: **javascript:openWin ...** and when you click the link, the link opens in another window.

When things stop working as you would expect, check again:



Error on page.



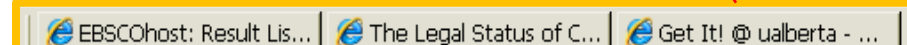
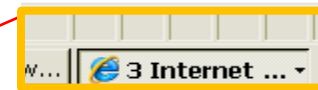
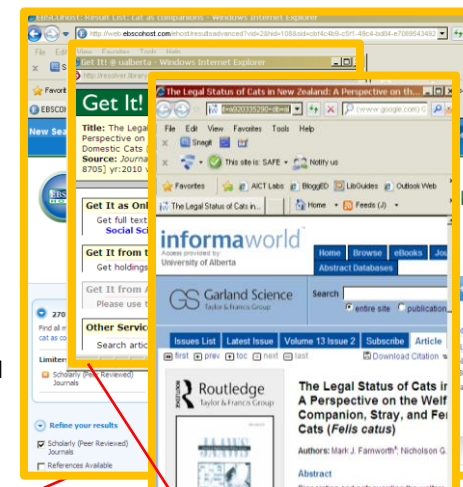
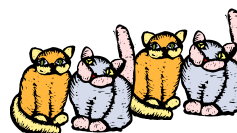
and when you click the link, ...the link DOES NOT open!!





Good news! This happens:

- 1) if you clicked the link twice,
- OR
- 2) if you have too many IE windows open!


So, just close the IE windows that you are not using, and you can continue without interruption.

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


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
